- March (extended spring break, one week to pivot)
- Remote Learning at Richland

Spring 2020 Overview of Canvas Use

- Population
 - Credit on-campus traditional
 - Online
 - Hybrid course selections
- 62% of students taking at least one hybrid and/or online course
- 38% of students taking ONLY traditional courses
- 99% students completed the student orientation
 - Spring 2020, Jones, J. and Jones, K.

Spring 2020 Overview of Canvas Use

- Faculty Preparedness

- 99% of the faculty teaching completed Canvas training
- 40% were teaching hybrid and/or online courses
- 60% were teaching ONLY traditional courses

- Course Sections

- 19% Online
- 19% Hybrid
- 62% Traditional
- 68% of course sections taught by faculty trained to teach hybrid or online

Planning for Fall 2020

Three Instructional Models

- Traditional Online – static
- Online Live – real time instruction
- Hybrid – lecture online and face to face for labs

Summer Professional Development

- 7 week Bootcamp
- Facilitated by Online Learning

Student Feedback for Review and Plan

- 617 Respondents
- 60% Online Live

Student Feedback for Spring 2021

- What is going well in online live course sessions?
 - Content is interesting 58%
 - Instructor is knowledgeable 82%
 - Opportunities to interact with classmates 52%
 - Interesting Discussions 52%
 - Comfortable environment 74%
- Top comment – more time to study with reduced commute time

Student Feedback for Spring 2021

- What could be improved in online live course sessions?
 - 46% Use of technology
 - 44% Interaction with classmates
- Opportunities to interact with instructor and classmates
- Instructor's teaching/technology skills
- Students' technology skills

Student Feedback for Spring 2021

- Would you take an online live course in Spring 2021?
 - 73% yes
 - 27% no
- What would keep you from taking an online live course?
 - Prefer in-person classes
 - Don't feel they learn as well online
 - Work and/or home life schedule
 - Overall discomfort using Zoom

Student Feedback for Spring 2021

- What time slots would work best for you to take online live courses?
 - 61% Morning
- What subjects do you think are best taught in an online live format?
 - Math
 - Science
 - English
- Is there anything limiting your ability to participate in courses this semester (online live, online and/or hybrid)?
 - Work schedule
 - Unreliable internet
 - Childcare

Student Feedback for Spring 2021

- Are you planning to register for the spring 2021 semester? Why or why not?
 - 88% yes
 - Graduating/Completed requirements for selective admission/goal
 - Transferring
 - Undecided
